

SCOPE-2 Registration Terms & Conditions

1. Scope and Acceptance

By clicking "I agree" and submitting the registration form, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to be bound by these **Terms & Conditions**. If you do not agree, please do not proceed with registration.

2. Eligibility

- Registration is open to students and participants invited or approved by the organizers.
- If you are under 18 years of age, you must obtain the consent of a parent or legal guardian before registering and participating in the event.
- All participants are expected to comply with the rules, policies, and code of conduct of the university and event organizers.

3. Registration Confirmation & Fees

- Your registration is confirmed only after receiving an official confirmation email.
- Registration may include one or multiple components (conference, workshops, etc.), each possibly with separate fees. Any applicable fees must be paid in full to secure your participation.

4. Payment and Fees

- Payment terms and options (e.g., credit card, bank transfer, etc.) will be specified on the registration page.
- Late or partial payments may result in cancellation of your registration.

5. Changes to Event or Program

- The Organizers reserve the right to modify the event's program, schedule, speakers, venue, format (in-person/virtual), or other components at any time (e.g., due to government restrictions, logistics, etc.).
- Such changes do not entitle participants to any refunds or other compensation.

6. Cancellation and Substitution

- If you wish to cancel your registration, you must notify the organizers in writing.
- Cancellation deadlines and associated fees (if any) will be clearly stated during registration.
- Substitutions (transferring your registration to another person) are permitted up to a specified deadline, subject to organizer approval and any applicable difference in fees.

7. Liability and Force Majeure

- You participate in the event at your own risk. The organizers are not liable for any personal injury, loss, or damage unless caused by their own gross negligence or willful misconduct.
- The organizers are not responsible for delays, cancellations, or disruptions due to force majeure events (e.g., weather events, health crises, political unrest, etc.) and will inform participants promptly if such circumstances arise.

8. Intellectual Property

- All content shared during the event—including presentations, documents, and recordings—is protected by intellectual property law.
- Reproduction, distribution, or public display of materials without the organizer's prior written consent is prohibited.

9. Recording and Media Release

- By attending, you consent to being photographed, filmed, and/or recorded. The organizers and their partners may use any such media for promotional and educational purposes across various media.

10. Data Privacy
